

Notes on the Manchester Area Chamber of Commerce annual meeting, 24 October, 2007

The meeting was opened by President Chris Fegan about 7:15 PM

Ballots for election of officers and trustees were distributed by Kari Newman.

The meeting was opened for nominations from the floor, no nominations were made from the floor.

Pat Vaillencourt moved that nominations be closed and nominations were closed.

Sharon Curtis announced that pursuant to the recently amended bylaws two trustees were to be elected for one year terms and three trustees were to be elected for two year terms. There was no differentiation on the ballot for one year and two year terms.

By general consensus of the members present it was agreed that the nominated persons receiving the five highest number of votes would be elected as trustees. The trustees elected with the larger number of votes would be elected for the two year terms and the trustees elected with the fewer number of votes would be elected for the one year terms.
